NEW EQUIPMENT GRANTS

On October 11, 2022, the Biden-Harris Administration announced plans to provide an additional \$50 million in school nutrition equipment grant funding, on top of the \$30 million in equipment grants offered earlier this year.

School meal programs can utilize the funds to purchase upgraded equipment to support efforts to serve healthier meals, implement scratch cooking, establish or expand school breakfast, store fresh food and improve food safety.
