The Summer Food Service Program (Pennsylvania Department of Education) will be starting in the Harrisburg, Philadelphia, and Pittsburgh areas again this summer and there are several Summer Food Service Monitor vacancies remaining.

The positions are non-civil service and work 8:00 am – 4:30 pm, M-F from June thru the end of August. Starting salary is \$10.15/hour. The applicant must have a valid driver's license in order to travel to the various sites.

The employees in these positions conduct monitoring visits of summer food service sites to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations. The employees collect statistical data and complete assessment reports regarding the operation of the sites.
