### Important Membership Update

As SNAPA continues to grow and expand our educational opportunities, we have found it necessary to discontinue our SNAPA Free State-Only Membership at the Food Service Employee/Staff Level. Effective October 1, 2018, SNAPA State-Only Membership dues will be reinstated at the cost of \$10.00 annually. Please note, SNAPA State-Only memberships are available to food service employee/staff level members only. As always, food service directors and manager members must belong to both SNA and SNAPA. ## BREAKFAST AFTER THE BELL GRANT OPPORTUNITY PENNSYLVANIA



Grants will support schools with the purchase of approved equipment, materials and initiatives facilitating breakfast after the bell delivery models (such as breakfast in the classroom, grab and go, or second chance breakfast) in an effort to increase student participation in school breakfast.

### ELIGIBILITY

Applying schools must either be implementing or be prepared to implement a breakfast after the bell delivery model.

### ELIGIBLE USE OF FUNDS

- Equipment purchases: insulated bags and grab-and-go carts
- Supplies: trash cans and bags
- Technology: point of service machines
- Promotional materials: banners and ads

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

To complete an application, you will need:

- School level breakfast and lunch participation data for the most recent month of October and total school enrollment
- FNS Director and application POC contact information
- Breakfast model you plan to implement, anticipated start date, and when/where you will serve meals
- Key strategies you have taken/plan to take to implement your program and anticipated challenges
- Detailed budget outline of grant request

### APPROVED ALTERNATIVE BREAKFAST DELIVERY MODELS

- Breakfast in the classroom
- Grab and Go to the Classroom, served at the start of the school day
- Second Chance Breakfast, served grab-and-go style to the classroom.
- Second Chance Breakfast, eaten in the cafeteria.
