USDA FARM TO SCHOOL CENSUS DEADLINE DECEMBER 6, 2019

REMINDER: Please Complete the USDA Farm to School Census

The 2019 Farm to School Census is reaching the home stretch, with the window for submitting surveys closing December 6! USDA is encouraging all school food authorities (SFAs) to complete their Census surveys as soon as possible to ensure that their important work is reflected in this updated report.

The Farm to School Census is the only nationwide survey measuring the extent of Farm to School activity in schools and the utilization of local food products in school feeding programs. In this year's Farm to School Census, USDA is collecting information from all schools participating in Federal School Meal Programs; including public and private schools, charter schools, and residential facilities.

If you are an SFA, your PEARS main contact should have received information by email from Abt Associates regarding completion of the survey beginning in late summer 2019. If you have questions regarding your Farm to School Census Survey, please contact Abt Associates by phone or through email.

Whipped Pumpkin Dip recipe.

Ingredients:

1 (80z) package cream cheese, softened

1 cup pumpkin puree

1/2 c confectioner's sugar

2 tsp pumpkin pie spice

1 (8 oz) container frozen whipped topping, thawed

Directions: Beat cream cheese in a bowl with an electric mixer until smooth; mix in pumpkin puree until smooth. Stir confectioner's sugar and pumpkin pie spice into mixture until evenly mixed; fold in whipped topping. cover bowl with plastic wrap and refrigerate for flavors to blend, about 2 hours. Can serve with ginger snaps, vanilla wafer or graham crackers.
