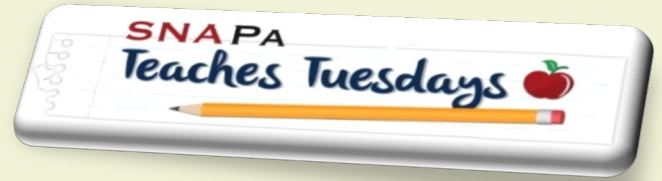
CN Directors asked if we would consider developing a Standard Operating Procedure re: Face Mask Use for their team and their Food Safety Plan.

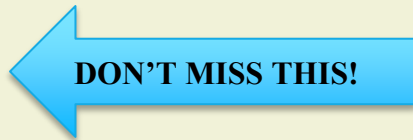
