

Important Dates and Deadlines:

- March 31st: Last day to complete the Direct Certification Process for districtwide CEP Sponsors in PA-SES powered by PrimeroEdge.
- April 1st: Last day to enter a January claim for reimbursement.

Charge Policies

All schools participating in the SNPs are required to have a Local Meal Charge Policy which serves to balance the nutritional needs of students and the financial integrity of the food service account. The policy must address the steps the school will take to collect debt and determine the point in which delinquent debt becomes uncollectable.

- Debt cannot carry over for longer than one school year.
- Student debt cannot be paid from the Food Service Account.

SFAs are encouraged to have a written policy determining what will happen to remaining meal funds at the end of the school year.

- Every effort to return funds must be made in accordance with the schools' debt collection policy.
- Funds that are not returnable within three (3) years are deemed Unclaimed Property and must be sent to the Department of the Treasury.

Direct Certification for CEP Schools

The deadline to perform the Direct Certification Process in the PA Student Eligibility System (PA-SES) for districtwide CEP sponsors is **March 31**st. The process of Direct Certification:

- Establishes SFAs initial or recalculated identified student percentage (ISP)
- Allows SFAs to take advantage of any ISP increases.
- · Helps SFAs observe demographic trends.

PDE, DFN recommends completing this as soon as possible.

Important Note: All sponsors are reminded to doublecheck student eligibility imports to ensure that all students are processed in the data file and are correctly coded to their respective school buildings.
