New Eligibility Guidelines For Free And Reduced School Meals Announced For The 2023-24 School Year

The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) has announced the release of federal income eligibility guidelines by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for free and reducedprice school meals and free milk from July 2023 to June 2024. These guidelines are used by schools and other institutions to determine eligibility for various programs, including the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program.

Different application processes exist for households receiving benefits from SNAP or TANF and those enrolled in WIC or Medicaid. The institution is prohibited from discrimination based on various factors, and alternative means of communication are available for individuals with disabilities. Complaints regarding program discrimination can be filed through the USDA.
