Assistant Director of Child Nutrition Services, Allentown School District

Position is expected to develop managers and support personnel to become independent thinkers and to use sound judgment (based on CNS standards and procedures.) Reports to Director of Child Nutrition Services.



Food Service Director, Mifflinburg Area School District

The Mifflinburg Area School District is accepting applications for the position of Food Service Director. The District is located in Central Pennsylvania in Union County and has an enrollment of approximately 1800 students across 4 buildings.

The Food Service Director is responsible for administering all aspects of the school district's food service program in compliance with federal, state, and local regulations and district policies. Candidates must be knowledgeable in budgeting, purchasing, menu planning, meal preparation, serving and health & safety standards. Fulltime (12 month) Administrative Act 93 position, starting salary to commensurate with experience.

Numbers on this site reflect the "national average payments," the amount of money the federal government provides states for lunches, afterschool snacks, and breakfasts served to children participating in the <u>National School</u> <u>Lunch and School Breakfast</u> Programs.

The annual payments and rate adjustments for the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs reflect changes in the Food Away From Home series of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers. The annual rate adjustment for the Special Milk Program reflects changes in the Producer Price Index for Fluid Milk Products.

These payments and rates are in effect from July 1 through June 30 every year.
